Regular sessions meet from 1:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on the following Thursday dates: October 21, November 4, December 2, January 6, February 3, February 17 and April 7. Should one of the above dates be cancelled, the make up date will be April 21. The all-day trip to the State Capitol will be Wednesday, March 2, 2011.
